

## **Archiva Moldaviae”, Volume VIII/2016, has Appeared**

In volume VIII/2016 of „Archiva Moldaviae” (462 pages) you can find studies of history, memories/interviews, documents, reviews, bibliographic notes, and presentation of scientific life. Among the topics touched by the 36 authors we mention: the narrative of the embassy of the King of Poland in Constantinople, in 1624; the history of Moldavian army at the early of eighteenth century; the condemnation of tobacco in the Romanian society; ethnic violence in Bessarabia, in the late nineteenth century; the memory of the Holocaust; religion, politics and the identity issue on both sides of the Prut river in the first half of the twentieth century; the Hitler-Stalin pact in the perspective of history, memory and international law; the Eastern European postwar communism, where are treated Soviet advisors in Poland, education and science of Moldaviann SSR and Romania during sovietization; communist Romania seen in Paris, 1977-1989.
