This letters content information about the personal life of Cristian Racovsky and about many Bulgarian politicians and intellectuals from the time before the Balkan wars, such as Nikola Sakarov, Gheorghii Bakalov, Aleksandăr Radev, Ianko Sakâzov, Aleksandăr Malinov, Ivan Vazov etc.
