The Romanian Space in Russian Topographic and Cartographic Sources from Kiev* (Abstract)

Keywords: Russian topographic documents, Popești, Odessa, Odessa Historical Society, Kiev.

Recently, at the National Library of Ukraine in Kiev we found several topographic and cartographic documents regarding the Romanian space. We got copies of 13 such historical sources together with the drawing of some stones with inscriptions, most likely from the time of the Romans. Some plans, including that of the city of Iaşi and those of the citadel of Brăila, have been published separately. Those concerning the Ottoman Hârşova are to be included in other contributions. We wrote an inventory of the documents from Kiev with some data about the battle of Popeşti, between the Russians and the Turks, annexing the plan of this battle. All the topographic and cartographic sources described in this study once made up the collection of the Odessa Historical Society Museum.
